

Collaborative Class Book Lesson Plan - Grades 6-12

Automatically collect student's content into a printable digital book.


1. Teacher signs up and buys 1 licence at \$10USD: <https://familybookform.com/>
2. Teacher invites up to 300 students to contribute to the Collaborative book.
3. All content automatically collated into a digital book, share online, download a PDF.

Step 1: Teacher Sign up

1. Teacher **'signs up'** on the website, everytime thereafter **'sign in'** on the website.
2. To create 1 class book buy one licence at \$10USD - you can invite up to 300 students to contribute to that book.
3. At Step 3 of the signup process a unique url is generated for your 'Project' (**1 url link is generated for all of that project's licences**). Every time someone 'signs up' using that link 1 licence will be used.

If you have purchased the licence(s) you need to use a different email to click on the project's url link to create a book.

4. Click on the Project's unique url link to open the book-creating dashboard. Name your Class book, upload a photo to the front cover, write or speak an introduction.
5. All content is automatically collated into a digital book, with front cover, chapters and sections, hosted online for 1 year. Download a PDF to print on demand.

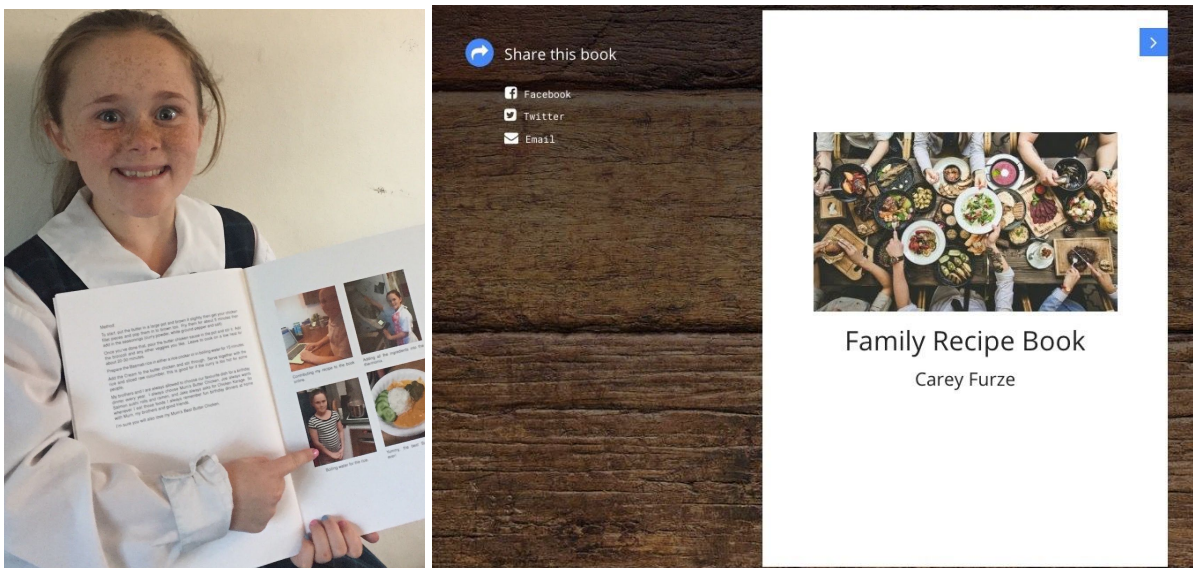

Step 3: Share the Book - automatically creates a digital book & PDF to download

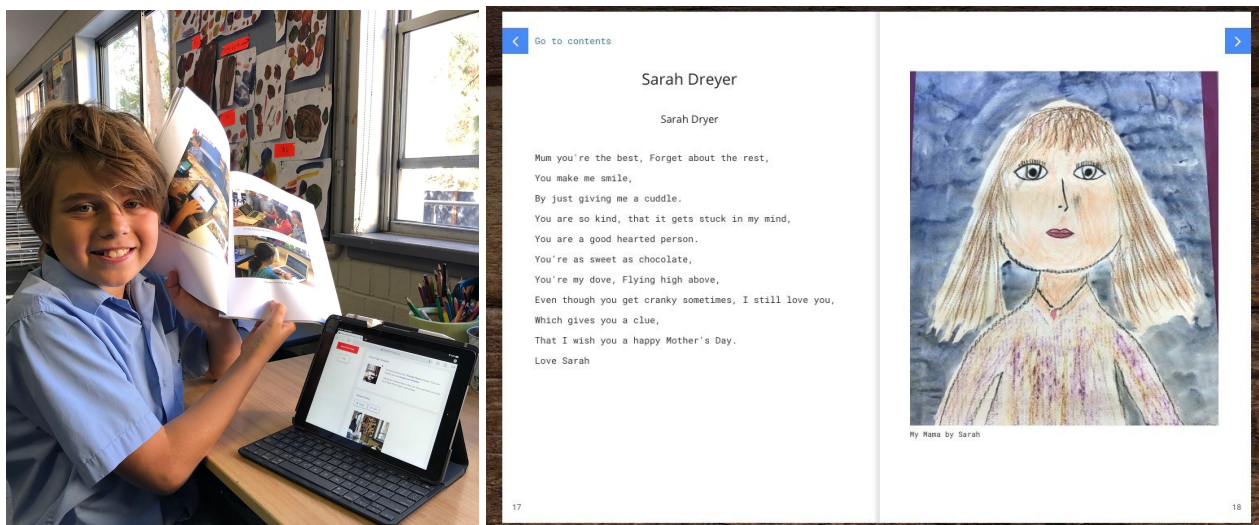
1. Share the digital book in the classroom for story-sharing, collaborative editing & enrichment.
2. All book content is private to the book-creator host (teacher), until shared.
3. Share the book online with your student's families and community. Available online for 1 year.
4. Download a PDF to print on demand.
