


STEAM Project - Mother's, Father's or Grandparent's Day Automatically collect content into a printable digital book

Project 1: Teacher's Collaborative Book - Grade 6-8

- 1. Teacher invites the Class to contribute to the Collaborative book.
- 2. All content automatically collated into a digital book, share online, download a PDF.
- 3. Students gift or sell the book to families at a celebration ceremony at school.

Mother's Day Book - Students contributed a poem & picture of their Mother.



Timeline:

1-2 hours Class Activity - Introduce students to FamilyBookform program

Explain the project, display example digital books on the smart board or their devices.

- What will the students contribute? What's the Class Book about and for?
- 200-220 words fit onto a page and 1 photo page gives each student a double-page spread.
- Invite the students through your book-creating dashboard using the 'Collaborations' button.
- Walk students through the sign-up process, they click on the automated link sent to their email and they sign-up using their Google sign-in or their email.
- Demonstrate how they can write directly into their FamilyBookform template page.
- Demonstrate how they can choose a picture page from the template and upload photos into the template.
- Demonstrate how they can log in and out to continue creating their contribution outside of class.

2-4 hours Class Activity - Students present their contribution

Display the digital Class Book on the smartboard or send the book's url link to the students via email.

- Students can click on the book's url link at any time to see the instantly updated book.
- Students take turns to discuss their contribution and the class can give feedback or help edit the text.
- Invite student's families to the school for a book presentation ceremony.



Project 2: Student's Favorite Food Book - Grade 7-12

- 1. Students invite their Family and Friends to contribute to their Favorite Recipes Book.
- 2. All content automatically collated into a digital book, share online, download a PDF.
- 3. Students gift or sell their books to families at a celebration ceremony at school.

My Family's Favourite Recipes Book - students collect their family's favourite food into a book.



Timeline:

2-4 hours Class Activity - Introduce students to FamilyBookform program

Explain the project, display example digital books on the smart board or their devices.

- Assign this project to students through Google Classroom. <u>Explainer video</u>. Or copy the Project's url link in your FamilyBookform dashboard & send to the students.
- Walk students through the sign-up process, they click on the Project's url link sent to their email and they sign-up using their Google sign-in or their email. Each student sign-up will use one licence.
- Show the explainer 'How It Works' videos on the main website, as an overview.
- Display your demo book on the smartboard to walk students through the book-creating dashboard's buttons.
- Demonstrate how they can write directly into their FamilyBookform template page.
- Demonstrate how they can use the speech-to-text function to speak their content into their book or use when interviewing others about their favorite food and why it's their favorite.
- Demonstrate how they can invite others to contribute their favorite recipes, stories & photos.
- Demonstrate how they can choose a picture page from the template and upload photos into the template.
- Demonstrate how they can log in and out to continue creating their contribution outside of class.

4-8 hours Class Activity - Students present their Books

Display each student's digital Book on the smartboard.

- Students take turns to discuss their contribution and the class can give feedback or help edit the text.
- Enrich lessons, especially writing, history, social studies, art and technology.
- Opportunities to cook student's recipes at school for a diversity day feast.
- Students gift or sell their books and present to families at a celebration ceremony.
